 Readers: Usher (7:00 AM) | Ms. Patrice Wallace (9:30 AM)

*Reader: A Reading from the Word of God written in the Book of Ecclesiasticus.*

- <sup>1</sup> Let us now sing the praises of famous men, our ancestors in their generations.
- <sup>2</sup> The Lord apportioned to them great glory, his majesty from the beginning.
- <sup>3</sup> There were those who ruled in their kingdoms, and made a name for themselves by their

valour; those who gave counsel because they were intelligent; those who spoke in prophetic oracles;<sup>4</sup> those who led the people by their counsels and by their knowledge of the people's lore; they were wise in their words of instruction;<sup>5</sup> those who composed musical tunes, or put verses in writing; <sup>6</sup>rich men endowed with resources, living peacefully in their homes—<sup>7</sup>all these were honoured in their generations, and were the pride of their times.<sup>8</sup> Some of them have left behind a name, so that others declare their praise.<sup>9</sup> But of others there is no memory; they have perished as though they had never existed; they have become as though they had never been born, they and their children after them.<sup>10</sup> But these also were godly men, whose righteous deeds have not been forgotten;<sup>11</sup> their wealth will remain with their descendants, and their inheritance with their children's children. <sup>12</sup>Their descendants stand by the covenants; their children also, for their sake.<sup>13</sup> Their offspring will continue for ever, and their glory will never be blotted out.<sup>14</sup> Their bodies are buried in peace, but their name lives on generation after generation.<sup>15</sup> The assembly declares their wisdom, and the congregation proclaims their praise.

*Reader: A Reading from the Word of God written in the Letter to the **Philippians**.*

<sup>10</sup>I rejoice in the Lord greatly that now at last you have revived your concern for me; indeed, you were concerned for me, but had no opportunity to show it. <sup>11</sup>Not that I am referring to being in need; for I have learned to be content with whatever I have. <sup>12</sup>I know what it is to have little, and I know what it is to have plenty. In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being well-fed and of going hungry, of having plenty and of being in need. <sup>13</sup>I can do all things through him who strengthens me. <sup>14</sup>In any case, it was kind of you to share my distress. <sup>15</sup>You Philippians indeed know that in the early days of the gospel, when I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you alone. <sup>16</sup>For even when I was in Thessalonica, you sent me help for my needs more than once. <sup>17</sup>Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the profit that accumulates to your account. <sup>18</sup>I have been paid in full and have more than enough; I am fully satisfied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent, a fragrant offering, a sacrifice acceptable and pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup>And my God will fully satisfy every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

<sup>9</sup>And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of dishonest wealth so that when it is gone, they may welcome you into the eternal homes. <sup>10</sup>Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. <sup>11</sup>If then you have not been faithful with the dishonest wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? <sup>12</sup>And if you have not been faithful with what belongs to another, who will give you what is your own? <sup>13</sup>No slave can serve two masters; for a slave will either hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to the one and despise the other.
