

# PRAYER FOR THE HURRICANE SEASON

Lord Jesus Christ, as You saved Your apostles from perishing in a storm by calming wind and waves on Your command, so now keep us safe and sound during this hurricane season. Grant us favourable and benign weather. Protect us from the unpredictable elements of nature. Spare us from storm, flood, fire, illness, injury, disaster, and sudden death. Preserve us, we pray, from all evil and harm. For we look to you, who lives and reigns with the Father and the Holy Spirit, now and for ever. **Amen**

<sup>1</sup> Let us now sing the praises of famous men, our ancestors in their generations. <sup>2</sup>The Lord apportioned to them great glory, his majesty from the beginning. <sup>3</sup>There were those who ruled in their kingdoms, and made a name for themselves by their valour; those who gave counsel because they were intelligent; those who spoke in prophetic oracles;<sup>4</sup> those who led the people by their counsels and by their knowledge of the people's lore; they were wise in their words of instruction;<sup>5</sup> those who composed musical tunes, or put verses in writing; <sup>6</sup> rich men endowed with resources, living peacefully in their homes—<sup>7</sup> all these were honoured in their generations, and were the pride of their times.<sup>8</sup> Some of them have left behind a name, so that others declare their praise.<sup>9</sup> But of others there is no memory; they have perished as though they had never existed; they have become as though they had never been born, they and their children after them.<sup>10</sup> But these also were godly men, whose righteous deeds have not been forgotten;<sup>11</sup> their wealth will remain with their descendants, and their inheritance with their children's children. <sup>12</sup> Their descendants stand by the covenants; their children also, for their sake.<sup>13</sup> Their offspring will continue for ever, and their glory will never be blotted out.<sup>14</sup> Their bodies are buried in peace, but their name lives on generation after generation.<sup>15</sup> The assembly declares their wisdom, and the congregation proclaims their praise.

**Reader:** A Reading from the Word of God written in the Letter to the **Philippians**.

<sup>10</sup> I rejoice in the Lord greatly that now at last you have revived your concern for me; indeed, you were concerned for me, but had no opportunity to show it. <sup>11</sup> Not that I am referring to being in need; for I have learned to be content with whatever I have. <sup>12</sup> I know what it is to have little, and I know what it is to have plenty. In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being well-fed and of going hungry, of having plenty and of being in need. <sup>13</sup> I can do all things through him who strengthens me. <sup>14</sup> In any case, it was kind of you to share my distress. <sup>15</sup> You Philippians indeed know that in the early days of the gospel, when I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you alone. <sup>16</sup> For even when I was in Thessalonica, you sent me help for my needs more than once. <sup>17</sup> Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the profit that accumulates to your account. <sup>18</sup> I have been paid in full and have more than enough; I am fully satisfied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent, a fragrant offering, a sacrifice acceptable and pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup> And my God will fully satisfy every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
